SXSW, *Austin* — Making it's U.S. Premiere at SXSW, Paul Fox's second film *Everything's Gone Green*, follows a talented hobbyist photographer named Ryan who feels like a loser. Stuck in a boring job, Ryan's only dream is to be middle class.

Ryan had a bad day, his girlfriend broke up with him, he was put on involuntary leave at work and when things seem to be getting worse, he finds out his family has just won the lottery... sort of. After discovering the lottery ticket wasn't actually a winner, Ryan somehow scores an interview with the lottery company. Then when Ryan gets mixed up with a beautiful woman named Ming and her boyfriend, he has to decide between being corrupt and having everything he wants or giving it all up for the woman he loves and achieving his goal of being middle class.
